History of the ARK

The ARK was started in the early 80's when, in the course of his research, Tony Amos began to find injured sea turtles and aquatic birds on the beaches and in the local environment. The program has grown to handle 800 native birds from hummingbirds to hawks, 200 endangered sea turtles and dozens of land turtles and small mammals each year. It has become an important rehabilitation facility on the Texas Coast.



Our Purpose

Friends of the ARK is a non-profit Texas corporation organized exclusively for the prevention of cruelty to animals.

We raise funds for the rescue of injured, sick and abused wildlife that will be rehabilitated, maintained and released back to their natural wildlife habitat or other licensed facility.

We also raise public awareness through our educational outreach programs.
